

Privacy Policy

Your privacy is critically important to us. At STANDARD CAPITAL we have a few fundamental principles: We don't ask you for personal information unless we truly need it. (We can't stand services that ask you for things like your gender or income level for no apparent reason.)

We don't share your personal information with anyone except to comply with the law, develop our services and investment solutions or protect our rights and website.

We don't store personal information on our servers unless required for the on-going operation of one of our services. In our investment products, we aim to make it as simple as possible for you to control what's visible to the public, seen by search engines, kept private, and confidentially.

Below is our Privacy Policy which incorporates these goals:

If you have questions about correcting your personal data please contact our customer support. STANDARD CAPITAL operates website. It is STANDARD CAPITAL policy to respect your privacy regarding any information we may collect while operating our website.

Usage of the Website

Like most website owners, STANDARD CAPITAL collect some of the non-personally-identifying information of the sort that web browsers and servers typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring website, and the date and time of each visitor request. The purpose of STANDARD CAPITAL is in collecting non-personally identifying information is to better understand how our customers and visitors use our website. From time to time, STANDARD CAPITAL may analyze non-personally-identifying information in the aggregate by publishing a report on common trends in the usage of our website. STANDARD CAPITAL also collects potentially personally-identifying information such like Internet Protocol (IP-addresses) for logged in customers.

The Personally-Identifying Information Collecting

We ask customers who to provide a username and email address. All our customers who engage in cooperation with STANDARD CAPITAL we are ask to provide additional information, including as necessary the personal and financial information required to process those financial transactions. In each case, STANDARD CAPITAL collects any such information only insofar as is necessary or appropriate to fulfill the purpose of the customer's interaction with STANDARD CAPITAL. STANDARD CAPITAL does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below. And any visitor can always refuse to provide personally-identifying information, with the caveat that it may prevent them from engaging in certain our website activities

If STANDARD CAPITAL, or substantially all of its assets, were acquired, or in the unlikely event that STANDARD CAPITAL goes out of business or enters bankruptcy, customer information would be one of the assets that is transferred or acquired by a third party. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur, and that any acquirer of STANDARD CAPITAL may continue to use your personal information as set forth in this Privacy Policy.

Protection of Certain Kinds of the Personally-Identifying Information

STANDARD CAPITAL discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only to those of its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations that

- need to know that information in order to process it on STANDARD CAPITAL behalf or to provide services available at STANDARD CAPITAL website, and
- that have agreed not to disclose it to others.

Some of those employees, contractors and affiliated organizations may be located outside of your home country.

By using the STANDARD CAPITAL website, you consent to the transfer of such information to them. STANDARD CAPITAL will not rent or sell potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information to anyone. Other than to its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations, as described above, STANDARD CAPITAL discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only in response to a subpoena, court order or other governmental request, or when STANDARD CAPITAL believes in good faith that disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect the property or rights of STANDARD CAPITAL, third parties or the public at large.

If you are a registered customer of the STANDARD CAPITAL website and have provided your e-mail address, STANDARD CAPITAL may occasionally send you an email to tell you about new features, solicit your feedback, or just keep you up to date with what's going on with STANDARD CAPITAL and our services and investment products. We primarily use our various services to communicate this type of information, so we expect to keep this type of e-mail to a minimum. If you send us a request (for example via a support e-mail or via one of our feedback instruments), we reserve the right to publish it in order to help us clarify or respond to your request or to help us support other members. STANDARD CAPITAL takes all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially personally-identifying and exact personally-identifying information.

Cookies

A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's or customer's PC, and that the visitor's or customer's browser provides to the website each time the visitor or customer returns. STANDARD CAPITAL uses cookies to help STANDARD CAPITAL identify and track visitors and customers, their usage of the STANDARD CAPITAL website, and their website access preferences. STANDARD CAPITAL visitors and customers who do not wish to have cookies placed on their computers should set their browsers to refuse cookies before using STANDARD CAPITAL website, with the drawback that certain features of STANDARD CAPITAL website may not function properly without the usage of cookies.

Aggregated Statistics
